Battery Chemistry Matters

Enphase uses lithium iron phosphate (LFP) cells. Safer? Absolutely. More expensive? You bet. Now, with CATL flooding the market with cheaper LFP batteries, will Enphase adjust pricing? They've remained mum since September's investor call.

When Competitors Beat Enphase on Cost

Tesla's Powerwall 3 undercuts Enphase by 18% now. But there's a catch - their availability's spotty east of the Mississippi. Generac's new PWRcell offers comparable specs at 12% less, though installation partners are still ramping up.

Here's where it gets interesting. EcoFlow's Delta Pro Ultra lets homeowners self-install for under \$10k. But will your insurance company cover garage-installed batteries? Unlikely. As one fire marshal told me, "We're seeing more lithium fires than ever before."
